Student

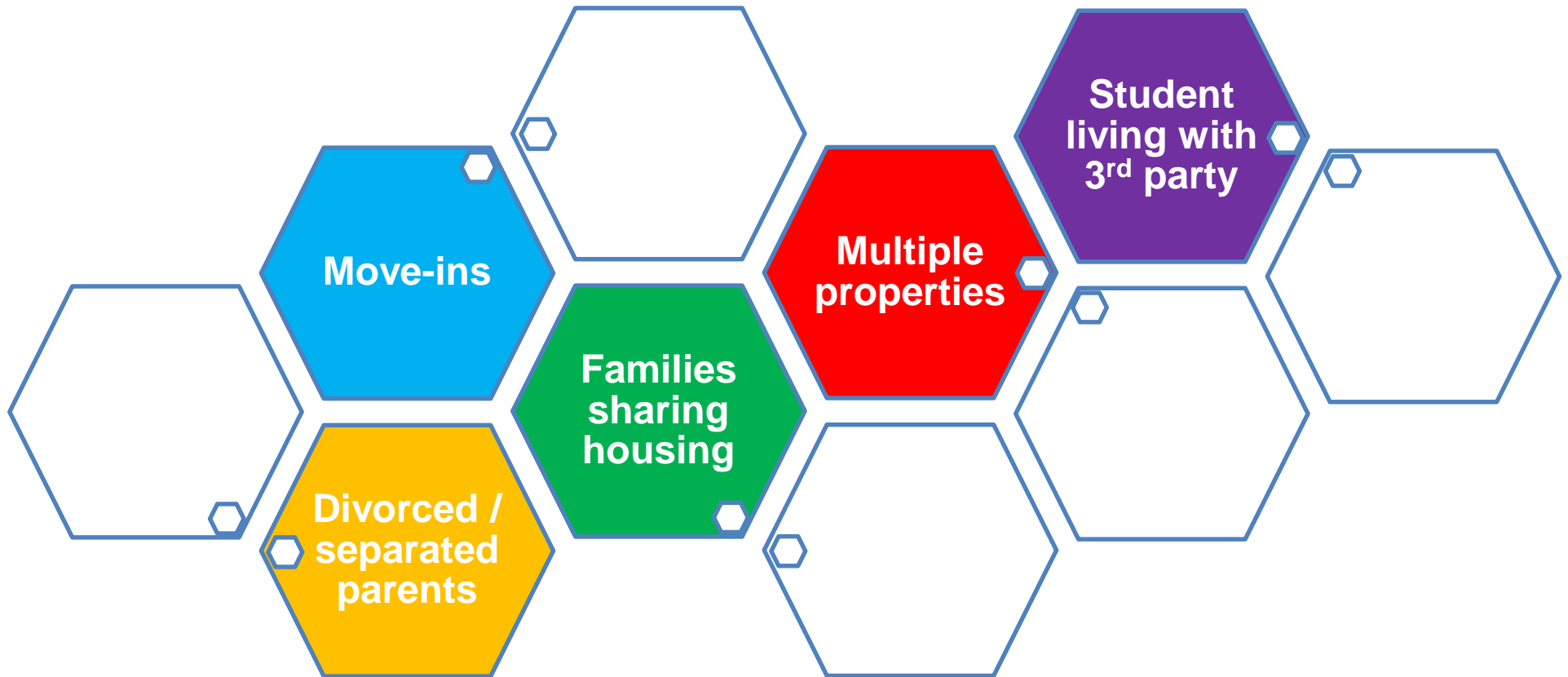
Student is 18 and no guardian appointed

Student is emancipated

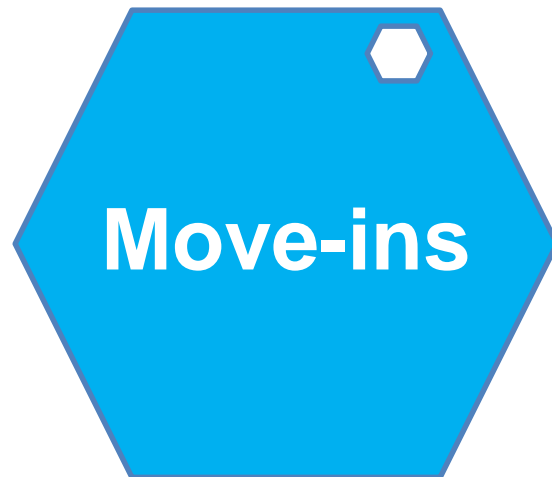
Location of parent or guardian is unknown

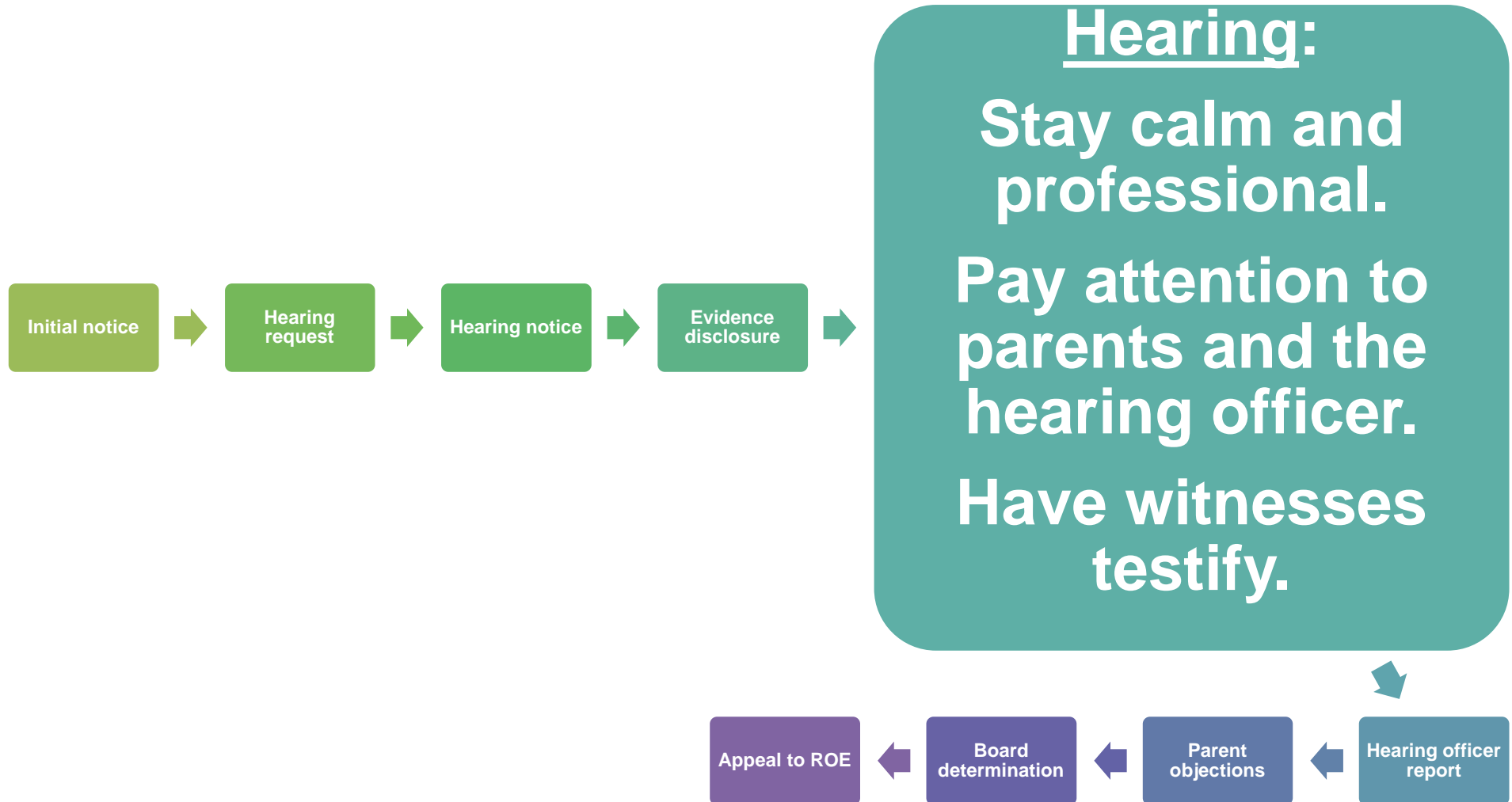
Initial notice:
Include specific reasons the district believes the student is not a resident.



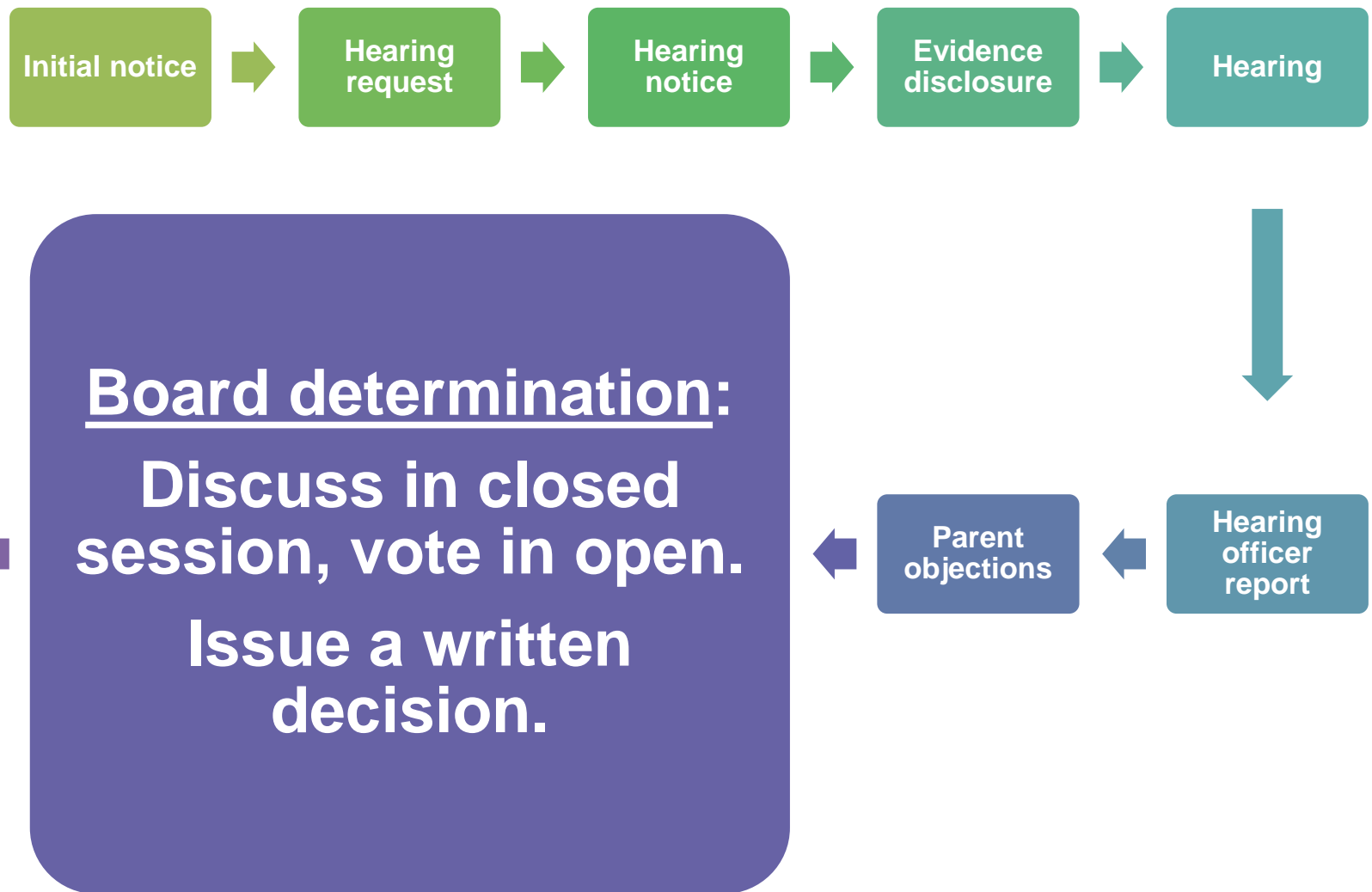

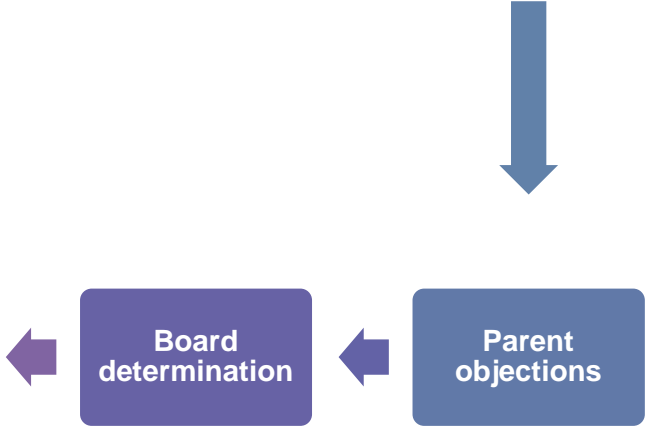
